I. Please write one long paragraph that addresses the following questions:

- * Why do you want to participate in this class and travel to Turkey?
- * How do you imagine this course and travel in Turkey will contribute to your studies?
- * What skills would you bring to the group as a whole?

II. Please write a brief response to each of the following questions:

1. How will you prepare yourself to deal with the demands two weeks of very little privacy, frequent physical exertion (we anticipate that we will be walking between three and five miles each day), and a very different code of etiquette? If you are a vegetarian, how will you deal with situations in which there is little or no vegetarian food available to you? How would you cope with an itinerary that does not necessarily suit your personal interests at all times?

2. Do you have any medical concerns that will need to be addressed during our preparations for travel or during the trip? If you were to need medical attention on the trip, would you have any objections to being treated by a local doctor or with drugs such as antibiotics or Immodium?

3. What previous travel experiences have you had? Have you ever lived or traveled under difficult circumstances? Have you had many intercultural experiences? Please explain how you plan to cultivate meaningful encounters with people who may not speak the same language as you and come from a vastly different cultural background.

4. How intense is your planned workload for the Spring '13 semester? Will you be able to accommodate this 6-credit class taking into consideration that you will be fully occupied during your Spring Break.

5. Is there anything else you would like us to know and would help in our decision?
